Digital IT & Strategy



- Knowledge imparting on major concepts concerning the topic of Digital IT, IT-driven digital transformation, IT strategy, IT governance and IT process frameworks.
- Independent working on case studies focusing on practice-oriented implementation of digital IT and IT strategy-related concepts.
- Development of scientific papers or teaching cases.



Presentation

Digital IT & Strategy (Lecture 1): Lecture on IT strategy and digital IT concepts as well as introduction into case study work and solution development

IT Governance

- Case Study (Assignment 1): Independent work on IT strategy case studies within groups of 3-4 students
- IT Governance (Lecture 2): Lecture on IT governance; presentation of case study results by students
- Paper Development (Assignment 2): Development of a scientific paper or teaching case (8-10 pages).
- Result Presentation (Lecture 3): Presentation of scientific papers by students.

Course Details



- The lectures, all student presentations as well as all course materials will be in English only.
- The course size will be maximum 16 participants to encourage team work and participation. (Application through an ILIAS-based survey)
- The evaluation will be based on case study group work (30%), the development of the scientific paper or teaching case (group work; 50%), result presentations and active participation during the lectures (20%).
- The course will include several lectures (full-time from 9am to 6pm, for details see next slide).

The course will start in calendar week 16 (mid April 2017), the final result presentation session is scheduled for 7th July 2017.
